Community Services



Matt is a passionate and enthusiastic individual and is often described as quite eccentric. Coming from an upper-middle class upbringing he strongly feels a need to give back and assist those less fortunate and to raise community awareness. He was awarded the Young Manager Under 30 Award from the Australian Institute of Management in 2015 and works across a range of Homelessness and Mental Health Services.

The Ruah Centre is a homeless Drop-In Centre for those sleeping rough and who are homeless and has been around for some 50 years. Those coming through our doors are some of the most vulnerable and marginalized individuals living in our Perth Community.

This presentation will cover a range of services, and aims to give an insight into homelessness and how it impacts people living in Perth.
